

Положение eIDAS

Официальный журнал Европейского Союза от 23 июля 2014 г. содержит опубликованное Постановление Европейского Парламента и Совета (ЕС) № 910/2014

по электронной идентификации и услугам доверия в отношении электронных транзакций на внутреннем рынке и **отменяющее Директиву 1999/93/ ЕС** (так называемое Положение eIDAS [eIDAS]).

Дата публикации eIDAS: → 2014-08-28

Дата вступления в жизнь: → 2014-09-17

Дата начала действия: → **2016-07-01**

Дата отмены Директивы 1999/93/ ЕС: → **2016-07-01**



eIDAS 1.0 Новые требования рынка:

- положение применялось прежде всего к субъектам госадминистрации и самоуправлений,
- небольшие возможности и большие сложности частных поставщиков интернет-услуг использования и присоединения к таким услугам,
- доступность зарегистрированных решений электронной идентификации в странах ЕС не удовлетворяет требованиям,
- относительно электронной идентификации малая поддержка для многих и различных случаев использования,
- с другой стороны, электронная идентификация принадлежащая общественным порталам и финансовым субъектам вызывает опасения относительно безопасности данных, в том числе и персональных,
- все вышеуказанные виды электронной идентификации не всегда отвечают новым требованиям рынка, часто не имеют трансграничного масштаба, в особенности для отраслей, где идентификация есть уязвимым пунктом и требует высшего уровня уверенности.

eIDAS 1.0 Новые требования рынка:

- к 2030 **80% граждан** должны получать доступ к главным услугам сектора администрации пользуясь электронной идентификацией,
- отсутствие электронных атрибутов, например, дипломов, подтверждений специализации специалистов в электронном виде не даёт возможности юридического признания на общеевропейском уровне,
- услуги доверия, определенные в eIDAS, оказались эффективными, получили распространение при большинстве услуг, отмечено небольшое распространение QWAC,
- необходимость 3 новых квалифицированных услуг доверия: электронное архивирование, электронные книги/регистры, услуга управления удаленной подписью.

Qualified certificates for electronic signatures

6. **The Commission may**, by means of implementing acts, establish reference numbers of standards for qualified certificates for electronic signature. Compliance with the requirements laid down in Annex I shall be presumed where a qualified certificate for electronic signature meets those standards. Those implementing acts shall be adopted in accordance with the examination procedure referred to in Article 48(2).

In Article 28, paragraph 6 is replaced by the following:

Within 12 months after the entry into force of this Regulation, the Commission shall, by means of implementing acts, establish reference numbers of standards for qualified certificates for electronic signature. Compliance with the requirements laid down in Annex I shall be presumed where a qualified certificate for electronic signature meets those standards. Those implementing acts shall be adopted in accordance with the examination procedure referred to in Article 48(2).';

Certification of qualified electronic signature creation devices

1. Qualified electronic signature creation devices shall meet the requirements laid down in Annex II

.....

3. The certification referred to in paragraph 1 shall be based on one of the following:

(a) a security evaluation process carried out in accordance with one of the standards for the security assessment of information technology products included in the list established in accordance with the second subparagraph; or

eIDAS 2.0

In Article 30, the following paragraph 3a is inserted:

‘3a. The certification referred to in paragraph 1 shall **be valid for 5 years**, conditional upon a **regular 2 year** vulnerabilities assessment. Where vulnerabilities are identified and not remedied, the certification **shall be withdrawn.**’;

Article 29

Requirements for qualified electronic signature creation devices

eIDAS 2.0

In Article 29, the following new paragraph 1a is added:

‘1a. **Generating,** managing and duplicating electronic signature creation data on behalf of the signatory may only be done by a qualified trust service provider providing a qualified trust service for the management of a remote electronic qualified signature creation device.’;

‘Article 29a /Article 39a (seal)

Requirements for a qualified service for the management of remote electronic signature creation devices

1. The management of remote qualified electronic signature creation devices as a qualified service may only be carried out by a qualified trust service provider that:

(a) Generates or manages electronic signature creation data on behalf of the signatory;
(b) notwithstanding point (1)(d) of Annex II, duplicates the electronic signature creation data only for back-up purposes provided the following requirements are met:

the security of the duplicated datasets must be at the same level as for the original datasets;
the number of duplicated datasets shall not exceed the minimum needed to ensure continuity of the service.

(c) complies with any requirements identified in the certification report of the specific remote qualified signature creation device issued pursuant to Article 30.

2. Within 12 months of the entering into force of this Regulation, the Commission shall, by means of implementing acts, establish technical specifications and reference numbers of standards for the purposes of paragraph 1.’;

1. Secure signature creation devices of which the conformity has been determined in accordance with Article 3(4) of Directive 1999/93/EC shall be considered as qualified electronic signature creation devices under this Regulation.
2. Qualified certificates issued to natural persons under Directive 1999/93/EC shall be considered as qualified certificates for electronic signatures under this Regulation until they expire.

eIDAS 2.0

Article 51 is replaced by the following:

'Article 51

Transitional measures

1. Secure signature creation devices of which the conformity has been determined in accordance with Article 3(4) of Directive 1999/93/EC shall continue to be considered as qualified electronic signature creation devices under this Regulation until [date – OJ please insert period of four years following the entry into force of this Regulation].
2. Qualified certificates issued to natural persons under Directive 1999/93/EC shall continue to be considered as qualified certificates for electronic signatures under this Regulation until [date – PO please insert a period of four years following the entry into force of this Regulation].'

Article 14 **International aspects**

1. Trust services provided by trust service providers established in a third country shall be recognised as legally equivalent to qualified trust services provided by qualified trust service providers established in the Union where the trust services originating from the third country are recognised under an agreement concluded between the Union and the third country in question or an international organisation in accordance with Article 218 TFEU. 2. Agreements referred to in paragraph 1 shall ensure, in particular, that:

Where the Commission has adopted an implementing act pursuant to paragraph 1 or concluded an international agreement on the mutual recognition of trust services in accordance with Article 218 of the Treaty, trust services provided by providers established in the third country concerned shall be considered equivalent to qualified trust services provided by qualified trust service providers established in the Union.’;

Article 45 Requirements for qualified certificates for website authentication

eIDAS 2.0

2. Qualified certificates for website authentication referred to in paragraph 1 shall be **recognised by web-browsers. For those purposes web-browsers shall ensure that the identity data provided using any of the methods is displayed in a user friendly manner.** Web-browsers shall ensure support and interoperability with qualified certificates for website authentication referred to in paragraph 1, with the exception of enterprises, considered to be microenterprises and small enterprises in accordance with Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC **in the first 5 years of operating** as providers of web-browsing services.

'(42) **'European Digital Identity Wallet'** is a product and service that allows the user to store identity data, credentials and attributes linked to her/his identity, to provide them to relying parties on request and to use them for authentication, online and offline, for a service in accordance with Article 6a; and to create qualified electronic signatures and seals;

Article 6 is deleted;

Article 6a 1: each Member State shall issue a European Digital Identity...

*(a) by a **Member State;** ...*

*Article 6a 3: ... **sign by means of qualified electronic signatures.***

*Article 6c 1: European Digital Identity Wallets that **have been certified** or for which a statement of conformity has been issued under a cybersecurity scheme*

*Article 6a 11 : **Within 6 months** of the entering into force of this Regulation, the Commission shall establish technical and operational specifications and reference standards for the requirements*


